SCHEDULE - XII

Significant accounting policies and Notes on accounts

A. Statement of significant accounting policies

a. Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and on accrual basis of accounting and in accordance with the Accounting Standards (AS) issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

b. Revenue recognition

Income and expenditure are accounted for on accrual basis. Income accruing from deposits made out of earmarked funds is credited directly to the respective earmarked fund. Grants are accounted based on advice received from ICAI, New Delhi.

c. Fixed assets and depreciation

i. Fixed assets are stated at historic costs less depreciation.

ii. Depreciation on fixed assets is charged under written down value method as per the rates prescribed by ICAI.

iii. Depreciation is proportionately charged on additions/deletions to fixed assets other than library books.

iv. Library books are fully depreciated in the year.

B. Notes on Accounts

- a. 10% of Gross receipts from Seminars and Conference held at SIRC premises amounting to Rs. 2,92,396/- {previous year Rs. 2,47,676/-} has been transferred to Building Maintenance Fund account during the year. The balance of surplus of Rs. 9,00,145/- {previous year Rs. 21,62,966/} has been transferred to Coaching Class Reserves.
- b. Excess of Income over Expenditure in respect of the 43rd Regional conference has been recognized in the books of accounts.
- c. A sum of Rs. 95,173/- has been shown as other receivable in Schedule VI being the excess of expenditure over the Orientation Programme grant 2012. The same is subject to ratification by the Executive Committee of ICAI scheduled in May 2012. Consequent to the ratification the Orientation Expenses 2012 will be Rs. 8,45,173/- and ICAI Receivable Orientation 2012 will be Rs. 8,45,173/-
- d. All receivables in respect of 43rd Regional Conference, Newsletter Advertisement, creditors for expenses are subject to confirmation and consequential reconciliation.
