# Chairman's Communique...



### Dear Professional Colleagues,


Swachh Bharat Swasth Bharat Clean India Healthier India is one of the mottos of the present government. We the citizens of this country need to support this initiative by actively participating and contributing to this movement. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is a campaign by the Government of India to keep the streets, roads and infrastructure of the country's 4,041 statutory cities and towns and its rural areas clean. I am sharing my thoughts on the subject Swachh Bharat in this newsletter.

### Swachh Bharat Abhiyan

It has been the biggest ever cleanliness drive till date which has been organised by any Government. Since its launch on Oct 2, 2014 we have seen many initiatives being taken at All India Level to achieve the target of a "Clean India". It was apt for the government to associate the Abhiyan with the Father of Nation, Mahatma Gandhiji who was always the torch bearer for the cause of cleanliness. On 25th Dec 2014 Hon'ble Prime Minister nominated the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) for the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. By inviting people and institutions to participate in the drive, the Swachh Abhiyan turned to a National Movement.

### **Building of Toilets**

Under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, the government aims to make India Open Defecation Free (ODF) and achieve 100 per cent sanitation coverage by October 2019. From building over 3 Crore toilets, to educating people about cleanliness, waste management and hygiene, the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan has become a mass movement. As per the report, India's sanitation coverage in 2012 was merely 38 per cent which has currently increased to 60.53 per cent under the Swachh Bharat Mission.



### **Role of Corporate India**

Public and Private companies have also been appending in cleanliness activities under their compulsory Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) schemes which is a statutory requirement as per Companies Act, 2013. These projects include building toilets in distant villages, running workshops on behavioural changes, waste management, water hygiene and sanitation activities among other things. Corporate Affairs Ministry also amended Schedule VII of Companies Act to specify that contributions to 'Swachh Bharat Kosh' would be an eligible CSR spends. Therefore, not only government and private individuals but also the corporate sector is playing its role in making India totally clean. Let us educate our corporate clients and encourage them to take part in this movement.

### Happenings Around



Rs 65,000 crore GST credit: CBEC scans high-value claims The GST regime, which kicked in from July 1, allows tax credit on stock purchased during the previous tax regime. The Central Board of Excise and Customs has asked tax officials to verify GST transitional credit claims of over Rs 1 crore made by 162 entities. As much as Rs 65,000 crore out of the nearly Rs 95,000 crore tax collections in July — the first month of GST — have been claimed as transitional credit by taxpayers, prompting the CBEC to order a scrutiny of all cases above Rs 1 crore.

### I-T dept to launch jurisdiction-free assessment from October

The assessment of taxpayers is set to become jurisdiction-free. Come October, the income tax (I-T) department will launch a pilot project of the new system in Mumbai and Delhi to identify the loopholes. The project will then cover 100 cities in the first phase of implementation.



The system envisages allocation of a particular taxpayer's profile to any officer across the country via a special software. In the existing system, taxpayers are assessed in the specific region where they are based.

The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MoCA) has said as on Tuesday, it has identified 1.06 lakh directors of 'shell companies' for disgualification under the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 2013. This is part of actions to break the network of 'shell companies' and the fight against black money/money laundering activities, it said.

Download any free QR Scanner for Android/ios from the play store / appstore respectively

- 1. Open the QR Code reader on your phone.
- 2. Hold your device over a QR Code so that it's clearly visible within your smartphone's screen.



Two things can happen when you correctly hold your smartphone over a OR Code.

1. The phone automatically scans the code.

2. On some readers, you have to press a button to snap a picture, not unlike the button on your smartphone camera.

3. If necessary, press the button.

Your smartphone reads the code and navigates to the intended destination, which doesn't happen instantly. It may take a few seconds on most devices.

My concern about the Infrastructural facility of SIRC of ICAI.

We all know that our SIRC is located in Nungambakkam, a prime locality, in 21 grounds of land with three buildings each having a life span of different years. A Fund of 49.054 Crores was allocated earlier to construct and connect all the three buildings into one twelve storied SIGNATURE TOWER. This does not meet CMDA regulations, whose Building Regulations apparently need all the three buildings to be demolished and constructed as a single complex. Infrastructural committee organised several rounds of meetings. With no further development from our side, the funds that were allocated earlier by ICAI got lapsed. The proposal for the construction of SIGNATURE TOWER was announced by our immediate past president in the tax conference in August 2016 at Chennai. Some of the Council members we have now are beyond doubt and who do not insist that the building should come into existence during their period of presidentship / chairmanship but are in fear of criticism. The construction of SIGNATURE TOWER needs shifting of SIRC to new places for 2 or 3 years which needs a lot of energy and action, that could be handled and taken care well by our present Chairman.



This brand new building task needs a lot of decision making, leadership and experience which could be shouldered by our past presidents, past Chairmen and senior members. I am here in the Regional Council to blow the whistle whenever I find any anomaly in the construction of Signature Tower.
