## Dear Professional Colleagues,

**Stimulus Package:** Last month witnessed a stimulus package with historic fiscal measures by the Government of India for the economic development of our country. It is my sincere wish that our profession would also play a most appropriate role to realise the objectives envisaged by the Government through these endeavours.

One of the major practice areas of our members is certification function for business units when they approach financial institutions for their funding requirements. The efficiency of any financial system, which, inter alia, streamlines the savings of the masses to the users of funds (popularly

known as "financial intermediation" to a great extent depends upon the ethical approach of the borrowers and lenders. With Honesty and Integrity as the two important watchwords of our profession, we can ensure a sound financial intermediation in the country.

Artificial Intelligence, Robotics, Big Data, Data Mining, Block Chain, Internet of Things and other similar technological developments are impacting the way businesses are being and going to be conducted. Our Profession, which is known for its "Fit and Proper" criteria should equip itself on the way in which our services should be extended in the backdrop of the aforesaid technological advancements.

**Extension of last date for payment of Membership/COP fee:** The Council of ICAI has decided to extend the last date for payment of Membership /COP fee for the year 2019-20 up to 30th November, 2019. The Council of ICAI has decided to waive off condonation fees for delay of all online application forms / documents of members and students with transaction dates from 01st April, 2019 to till date and filed on or before 30th November, 2019.

**Extension of due date for filing of ITRs and Tax Audit Reports:** On consideration of representations received from various stakeholders across the country, Central Board of Direct Taxes, Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, Government of India has decided to extend the due date for filing of Income Tax Returns and Tax Audit Reports from 30th September 2019 to 31st October 2019 in respect of persons whose accounts are required to be audited.

**Field study amongst the Practice Units of our CA Profession:** Committee for Small and Medium Practitioners has commissioned a field study amongst the Practice Units of our CA Profession through an online questionnaire available at https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSd7fSy1npf\_09k\_Edq0NkPIUU75PCmdyZ4oWTg2zkhf-LKdUg/viewform?usp=sf\_link

I request our members to respond to this study in large numbers so that best practices could be identified and disseminated amongst our fraternity.

#### Programmes held during September 2019 at SIRC of ICAI:

We had evening CPE Meetings on the current and relevant topics, which are need of the hour for our members like Preparation of Financial Statements using MS-Excel, Audit Features in Tally and MIS tool for Tally & Beyond, SME Listing in NSE: SME Funding – The Role of Capital Markets, IPO Readiness, Red Flags in Financial Services, Audit of NBFCs- Role & Responsibilities of Auditors, etc.

We also had One Day Seminar on Direct Taxes at Chennai on 7th September 2019, which was inaugurated by our Past President ICAI CA. G. Ramaswamy. Eminent Resource Persons like CA. V. Ramnath from Coimbatore, Advocate K. K. Chaithanya from Bengaluru and CA. Naveen Khariwal from Bengaluru addressed the gathering.

As part of our Social Responsibility, SIRC has conducted Investor Awareness Programme, under the auspices of Investors Education and Protection Fund of Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Govt. of India and Committee on Financial Markets and Investors' Protection, ICAI. Dr. Somavalliappan spoke on Present Macro Economic Scenario of India - Concerns and Reality and Shri V. Nagappan spoke on Market Cycles.

SIRC in association with Society of Auditors conducted CA. N. C. Rajagopal Memorial Lecture on 3rd September 2019. Swami Atmashraddhananda, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama-Kanpur delivered the memorial lecture on Spiritual Basis of Indian Culture.





SIRC also had One Day Workshop on Tech Takeaways on the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016. The session was handled by CA. Dungar Chand U Jain, CA. Deephika and CA. Revathi S. Raghunathan. It was well received by the members.

Considering the extension of due date for filing GST Annual Return and Audit Report for FY 2017-18, from 31st August 2019 to 30th November 2019, SIRC has conducted One Day Seminar on Issues in GST Audit and Annual Return on 26th September 2019 for the benefit of Members.

SIRC facilitated the conduct of Round table Conference to discuss issues with regard to the need for regulation and development of valuation professionals at Chennai on 28th September 2019, initiated by ICAI Registered Valuers Organisation in association with Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI). Around 60 delegates representing various stakeholders of the valuation profession had discussed on 40 issues identified by the IBBI for providing strategic direction for the valuation profession in India. I place on record my sincere gratitude to CA. M.P. Vijay Kumar, CA. Rajendra Kumar P and my colleague in the council, CA. R. Revathi S. Raghunathan for effectively conducting the Round Table Conference.

### Announcement

ICAI made an announcement with respect to Evaluation of answer books of CA exams on 21st September, 2019. Thereafter, a webinar was conducted on 22nd September, 2019 wherein the procedure and processes followed in the examination system were explained and all the misgivings about the examination process were cleared. Further, an announcement elucidating Procedure and Process followed in Examination System was hosted on ICAI website on Sept. 24th, 2019.

The students were apprised once again about the step-wise marking which is an integral and essential feature of the evaluation system of ICAI w.e.f. November, 2018 examination. The ICAI also ensures that step-wise marking is carried out without fail and in case step-wise marks are not awarded, the Head-examiners are required to rectify the error during the process of review before results. Further, when such error is brought to the domain of the Institute during the process of verification or upon providing copies of answer books to the candidates, the same is also addressed and justice done to the candidates.

While providing copies of the answer books to the candidates, candidates are also specifically advised to bring to the notice of the Institute errors, if any, in the step-wise marks awarded which are also addressed by the Institute.

Students have been advised that in case they find any error in providing step-wise marks, they can send a mail about the same at verificationfinal@ icai.in and verificationintermediate@icai.in

As per the provisions of Regulations 39 (4) of Chartered Accountants Regulations, 1988, the correction of marks is awarded in the following cases:

- 1) No marks awarded to any answer or part of it.
- 2) Totalling errors in step-wise marks awarded for a answer
- 3) Wrong carry forward or its part of marks awarded to answer on the cover page of the answer books.

Beyond this, the Regulation does not permit any subjectivity in checking of answer. This aspect of explanation to regulation 39 (4) not permitting reevaluation has been upheld in many legal cases in which ICAI was a party.

Students are once again advised to repose their trust and faith in the examination system of ICAI which is time tested and robust.

Introduction of OMR answer sheets in respect of the Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) in Paper 6 of Final (New) Examination (Elective Paper), w.e.f November 2019 Examination
